
Perinatal Quality Collaborative (WisPQC)

Who We Are

Formed in 2014, the Wisconsin Perinatal Quality Collaborative (WisPQC) is grant-funded by the CDC through the Wisconsin Association for Perinatal Care (WAPC). Organizational membership is free. In 2020, Wisconsin was accepted as an Alliance for Innovation on Maternal Health (AIM) state through WisPQC.

WisPQC offers opportunities for stakeholders to engage in quality improvement initiatives that can lead to better perinatal outcomes. Through WisPQC, Wisconsin has the opportunity to leverage the energy of like-minded local, regional, and statewide organizations to form a lasting structure that will formally and systematically improve the quality of perinatal care and outcomes.

Charge: Identifies and defines neonatal initiatives and topics.

Data Work Group:

1:00 pm - 2:00 pm

3rd Thursday of odd months

Charge: Identifies data sources and stakeholders, works with other work groups to evaluate initiatives, and evaluates WisPQC overall.
